Advisor notes:

Accountancy students must have a 2.5 GPA between ACCT 4A and ACCT 4B.

Entrepreneurship students must have a B or better in ENTR 81.

Remember that there are specific milestones in your progress toward a degree that require mandatory advising. These are very busy times for the Craig School of Business Advising Center, so be proactive and schedule an appointment well in advance.

Advisor Notes:

**Accountancy:** Students who are interested in Accountancy need to have a 2.5 GPA between ACCT 4A and ACCT 4B (at least one must be a B or better). Additionally, we do not recommend students take more than two upper-division ACCT courses per semester.

**Entrepreneurship:** Students who are interested in Entrepreneurship need to earn a B or better in ENTR 81. Additionally, note that ENTR 157 is a spring only course with the prerequisites of ENTR 151 and ENTR 153, and ENTR 151 is a prerequisite for ENTR 153.

**General Finance:** Students who are interested in General Finance may need to work with the Finance and Business Law Department to have course substitutions approved for electives. Please note that courses must be approved *before* enrollment in the substitution.

**Computer Information Systems:** Students interested in Computer Information Systems need to complete the following courses in this sequence: IS 51 → IS 158 → IS 166 → IS 187

**Marketing:** Students interested in Marketing need to complete 7-8 units from the Marketing Electives list.

## GENERAL EDUCATION E-PORTFOLIO

All freshmen and transfer students admitted to Fresno State Fall 2018 and later will be required to submit assignments they complete for specific GE courses and reflections they write outside of class to a digital GE Program Portfolio.

## STUDENTS WHO ENTERED AS FRESHMAN

You will have assignments for all General Education courses you take through Fresno State. The GE Areas are: A1, A2, A3, B1, B2, B4, C1, C2, D1, D2, D3 (catalog year 2020 and before), E, F (catalog year 2021 and after), IB, IC, and ID.

You will be required to write reflections for 2 lower-division GE courses and 1 upper-division GE course.

**GE EPORTFOLIO****FRESHMAN GE ePORTFOLIO REQUIREMENT****TRANSFER GE ePORTFOLIO REQUIREMENT**

If you started attending Fresno State as a freshman or transfer student in Fall 2018 or more recently you are required to submit to the GE Program Portfolio for specific General Education areas.

You will automatically be enrolled in a GE Program Portfolio Canvas course to complete this requirement where you'll upload artifacts that were previously assigned in specific GE courses (assignments such as papers, recorded speeches, PowerPoints, quizzes, presentations, analytical essays, etc.).

**GE Program Portfolio Requirement**

Freshmen will submit an assignment from every GE course they take at Fresno State and write three reflections of at least three hundred words.

Transfer students will **ONLY** submit assignments from the three upper-division GE courses that they take (IB, IC, ID) and write one reflection of at least three hundred words.

Students will not submit assignments to GE Areas for which they have AP, IB, Exam, or Transfer Credit and will just ignore these areas in the GE Program Portfolio.

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## ZOOM

**Zoom**, Fresno State's new video and web conferencing tool, is now available to all students, faculty, and staff. It can be used from any computer, laptop, tablet, or phone, and it works on PC, Mac, Android and iOS devices. Any Fresno State user can initiate a video or audio meeting, allowing Zoom to be used for any online meeting, whether between two or many people. Anyone in the world can join a Zoom meeting, but only a host can start/schedule meetings.

Fresno State Faculty, Students, and Staff: Use your Fresno State ID and password to sign in to your host account. No account request required!

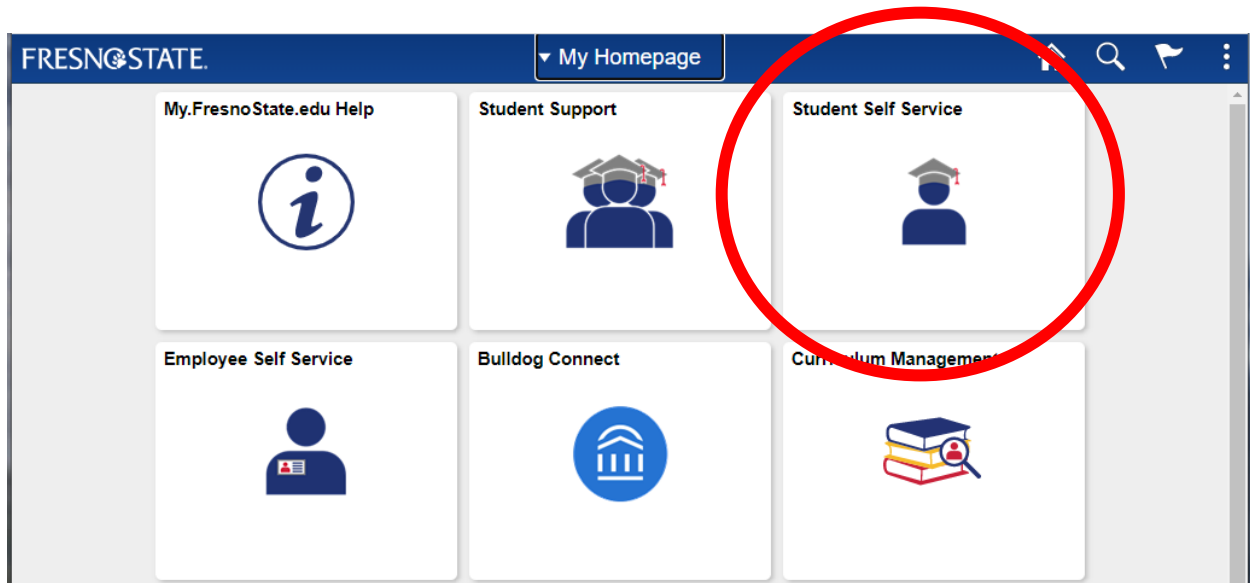

### HOW TO REGISTER FOR A SPECIFIC CLASS

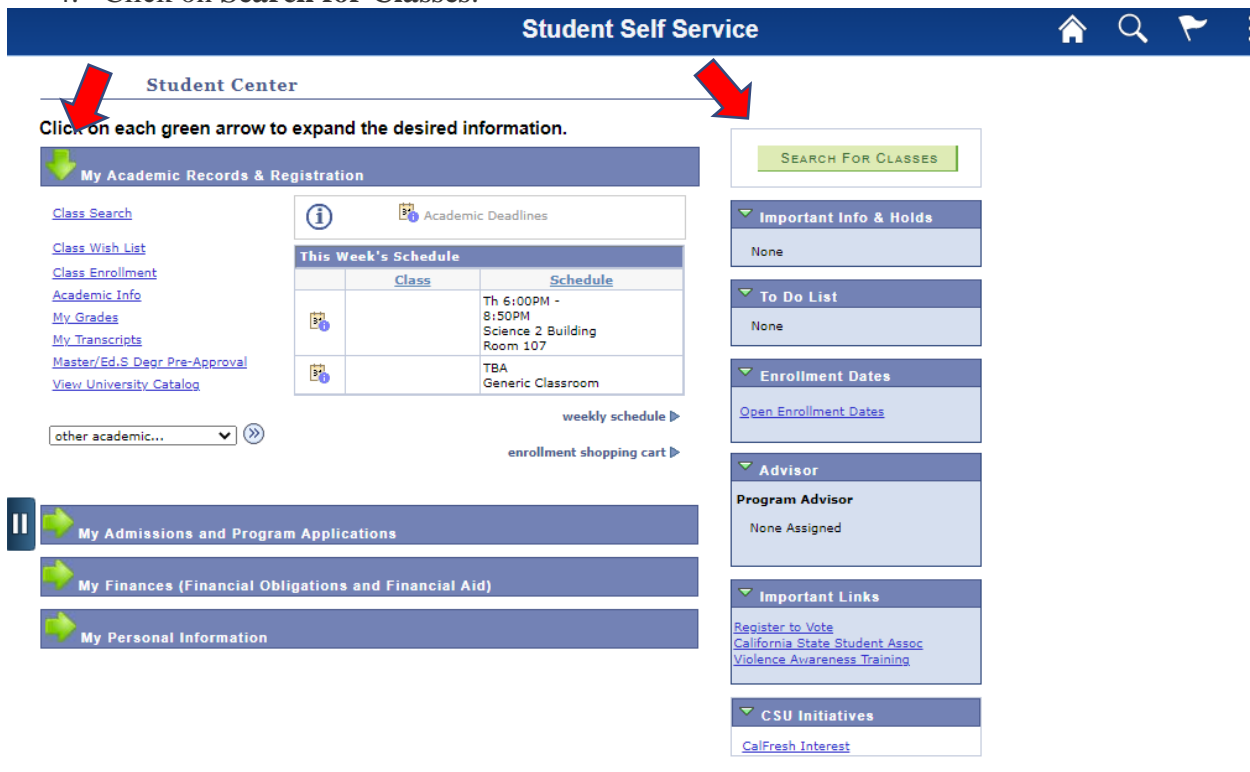
1. Log into My Fresno State web portal, [my.fresnostate.edu](http://my.fresnostate.edu)



- Under **My Menu**, click on **Student Self Service**, then click on **Student Center**



- To expand **My Academic Records & Registration**, click on the green arrow at the left of the bar.
- Click on **Search for Classes**.



- Select the term you wish to enroll in. Enter a **5-digit Class Number** in the **Class Number** box. Click on **Enter**. This will bring you to a new page. This page allows you

to verify your request, and if necessary, select a **related component**, such as a lab, **change your grading option**, or enter a **permission number**. At the bottom of the screen, click **Next** to proceed.

6. Use the **Search** feature to find open classes. Enter the course subject and course number (i.e. MGT 110) and click **Search** (leave the box checked to show open classes only). If you find a class you want to **add**, click on the **Select Class** button to add it to your Enrollment Shopping Cart.

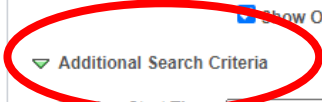

Transfer students must submit a complete set of transcripts (official or unofficial) or grade reports of all college-level study to the Craig School of Business Advising Center, 5245 N Backer Ave M/S PB 7, Fresno, CA 93740-8001 for evaluation. If you are transferring from out of the region, having a copy of the catalog(s) and course syllabi from the different colleges you attended will also be required. Upon receipt of these materials, transfer students' records will be evaluated. Notification of business course credit will then be sent by e-mail.

Students who are ready to enroll in upper-division business courses, but who lack one or two of the pre-business courses, should contact the Craig School of Business Advising Center in Peters Building (PB), Room 185 for further information.

A grade of "C" or better must be earned for each course used to satisfy the requirements for the major.
