
#### **Economics Flowchart Catalog Year 2020-2021**





## Craig School of Business Advising Center Mission





## Craig School of Business Advising Center

#### **Student Expectations**

#### **Students are expected to:**

- Be proactive about maintaining a relationship with your advisors
- Commit to appointment and understand the importance of punctuality
- Cancel an appointment at least 30 minutes before the appointment
- Arrive early for appointments and bring a photo ID for check-in
  - Students will not be seen without a photo ID
- Review <u>degree requirements</u> prior to coming into advising
- Create and update My Degree Plan each semester prior to coming into advising
- Make sound choices that are relevant to your degree requirements
- Come prepared with <u>questions</u> and take notes regarding the advising appointment
- Follow through with academic or career referrals
- For pre-business students, be aware of how and when to declare your option
- Bring all relevant documents for completion and any questions pertaining to the documents


